The conference program will involve an **online portion** (October 27th, Friday) and **two venues**, one in Dhaka (October 28th, Saturday, and another with a regional BELTA Chapter (October 29th and/or 30th, Sunday/Monday.

Presenters are expected to possess post-graduate degrees and have experience in giving presentations at academic conferences. Elementary, Junior High, High School, and University level teachers are encouraged to apply. The time structure for presentations will be 60 minutes and this can include time for Q & A.
